Greetings from the Dietary Department.

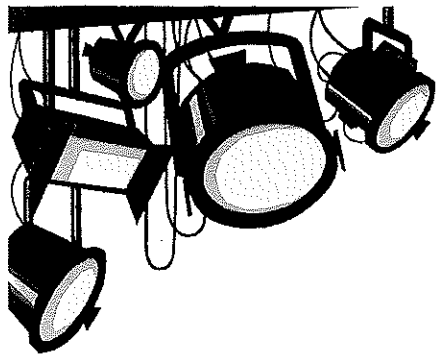

We hope you had a great holiday and best wishes for the New Year!

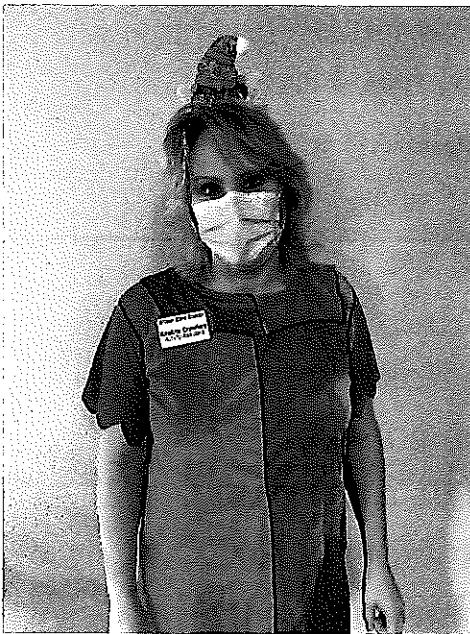

Crafts: I make signs, T-shirts & tumblers

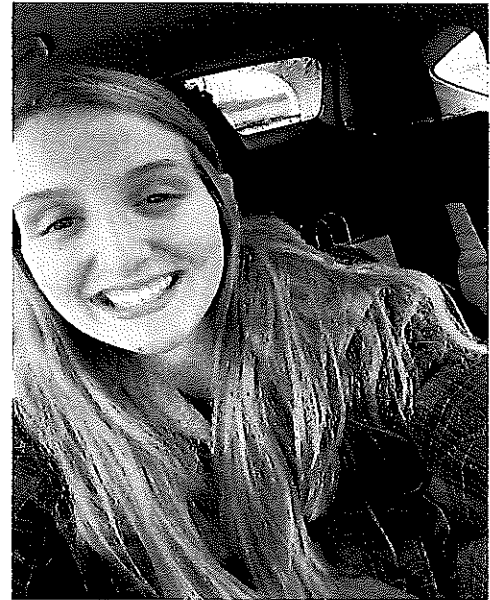
How long have you been at the Wilber Care Center? 2 years
